Carsharing companies promote a single use, single passenger approach which does not provide worthwhile incentives to the shared use of vehicles during trips. Ridesharing applications face the issue of unknown vehicles, unknown drivers, and minimal rewards to those willing to provide such a service in competition with public transportation or commercial taxi services. Likewise, it is nearly impossible to anticipate the trip destinations for such platforms.

Fleetzip focuses on existing communities, primarily through workplaces of any size. Through partnerships with auto dealerships and auto manufacturers, we know the exact specifications of the vehicles in use, we guarantee their maintenance, and since the vehicles are intended for commuting and work trips, we can anticipate the origin and destination to a great extent. Such conditions take a significant Drivers are then rewarded with mobility credits for assisting their fellow colleagues with rides to and from work, and trips from the workplace to job sites.
