

Reporting electricity credits to the Swedish Energy Agency

If someone in your organisation has a Swedish bank-id and have a power of attorney to represent the organisation, reporting the amount of electricity sold from public charging stations (for electricity credits) to the Swedish Energy Agency is done via the My Pages (Mina sidor) e-service Sustainable Fuels (Hållbara bränslen). There is an instructional video on how to apply for access to the e-service at the link below.

Reporting is then done using an Excel template called the fuel reporting template. You can find the template via the link below.

The Excel template can also be downloaded when you are logged in to the e-service. Below is a description of how to fill in the Excel template for fuel. The completed Excel template is then submitted via the e-service My Pages (Mina sidor).

If you do not have access to a Swedish bank-id you cannot use My pages (Mina sidor) to report the amount of electricity sold from public charging stations (for electricity credits) to the Swedish Energy Agency. In this case you need to send the information via mail to the address below:

Reporting via My Pages

Once you have applied for authorization, log in to My Pages (Mina sidor) and click on Create case. Click on the plus sign next to the Sustainable Fuels e-service and select the Report form.

Once you have opened the form, select the company you are reporting for and click as shown below under “Rapportering”:

Reporting the amount of electricity sold in the Excel template

This is reported under the Fuel tab (where those subject to reduction obligations and those covered by environmental information requirements can also report their fuel consumption).

There are several options for electricity under fuel – it is best to choose “Unmarked electricity (kWh)”, but it does not matter too much if you choose one of the other options for electricity. As the product name, choose a suitable name such as “electricity sold” so that it is clear to us that the information refers to electricity from public charging stations.

Reporting transfers of emission reductions

Companies that transfer electricity credits to others (or receive them) also need to report the transfers. This is done under the tab “Reduction obligation.”

Example of how to fill it in (charging operators do not need to fill in which fuel the transfer is for)

Additional documents to be attached or sent via mail

In addition to the Excel file in which you have specified the amount of electricity sold, you must also submit a statement from an auditor who has reviewed the amount of electricity sold, as well as copies of the agreements regarding the transfer of electricity credits to entities subject to the reduction obligation.
