


Guide to creation of users in the Union Registry






Introduction	<p>This guide describes how to create a user account and get started with the EU Login mobile app.</p> <p>The mobile app is required for authenticating yourself when logging in to the Union Registry and when approving transactions and other tasks.</p> <p>To become a representative for an account in the Union Registry, you must also submit a paper application including personal documentation. You can read more about the application procedure.</p>
Step by step	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Create an EU Login-account 2. Download the mobile app and add your mobile device to your EU Login account 3. Register a mobile phone number on your EU Login account 4. Register in the Union Registry





Step	Action	Interface
1. Create an EU Login account		
1.1	<p>Go to the Union Registry home page and click First time user.</p> <p>https://unionregistry.ec.europa.eu/euregistry/SE/index.xhtml</p> <p><i>If you want to change language, you can do so at the top right of the home page in both the Union Registry and EU Login</i></p>	
1.2	<p>Click Create an EU Login account.</p> <p><i>If you already have an EU Login account, go to step 2.1.</i></p>	

	<i>If you are already using the EU Login mobile app, go to step 4.1</i>	
1.3	Enter your name and e-mail address that will apply to your EU Login-account. When done, click Create an account .	
1.4	You will receive an automated e-mail with a link where you will create your password.	
1.5	Choose a password and click Submit . <i>Your EU Login account has now been created. You must now download the mobile app and associate it with your EU Login account</i>	
2. Download the mobile app and add your mobile device to your EU Login account		
2.1	Download the EU Login app to your mobile phone or other mobile device. The mobile app can be found on Google Play Store (Android) or App Store (iPhone). Then launch the mobile app. <i>Use of a lock function on your mobile device (PIN code, pattern or biometric code) is a requirement for using the mobile app.</i>	
2.2	The first time you use the mobile app, you will usually be asked if notifications can be sent to you, and if the app is allowed to use the camera. Select Allow and OK	

	<p><i>These permissions are necessary to be able to use the app.</i></p>	
2.3	<p><u>On your computer:</u> Before proceeding with the mobile app, you need to add your mobile device to your EU Login-account.</p> <p>Go to the EU Login webpage: https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/cas/</p> <p>Log in with the e-mail address you have previously used when logging in.</p> <p>Select verification method Password and log in with the e-mail address and password you have registered..</p>	
2.4	<p><u>On your computer:</u> Select Add a mobile device.</p>	 <p>Add a mobile device</p>
2.5	<p><u>On your computer:</u> Choose a name and PIN-code for your mobile device. Click Submit.</p>	
2.6	<p><u>On your computer:</u> A QR-code is displayed on screen. You must scan it with your mobile app.</p>	

2.7	<p><u>In the mobile app:</u> Open the app and select Initialize.</p>	
2.8	<p><u>In the mobile app:</u> Select Next.</p> <p>Use the mobile device camera to scan the QR code displayed in your computer browser.</p> <p><i>If the app requests access to the camera, you must approve this.</i></p>	
2.9	<p><u>In the mobile app:</u> Enter your selected PIN code and tap Authenticate.</p> <p><i>If the app doesn't respond, you can try the following:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Check if you have received a request from the app in the phone's drop-down menu</i> - <i>Check if notifications are disabled for your phone (or app)</i> - <i>Reinstall the app</i> 	
2.10	<p>A message (push notification) is displayed on your mobile device. Tap Approve to approve the request. Your mobile device is now registered for use with the EU Login mobile app.</p> <p>The next step is to associate a phone number to your EU Login-account. Your phone number is used as verification if you should lose the app's current configuration (for example, when reinstalling the app or switching to another mobile device).</p>	

3. Register a mobile phone number on your EU Login account		
3.1	Go to the EU Login webpage: https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/cas/ Select verification method EU Login Mobile App QR code .	
3.2	<p><u>On your computer:</u> A QR code is generated and displayed in your browser</p> <p><u>In the mobile app:</u> Open the mobile app, tap Scan QR Code and scan the QR code displayed in your browser.</p> <p>You will then receive a challenge code in the app that you must enter in the browser on your computer. You will then be logged in.</p>	
3.3	Hover the mouse over the gear icon in the top right and click My Account .	
3.4	Click Manage my mobile phone numbers .	
3.5	Click Add a mobile phone number . Enter your phone number including the country code. Click Add to confirm.	
3.6	You will receive an SMS containing a challenge code. Enter the code received on the newly added phone number and click Finalise . The next step is to register a user account in the Union Registry.	

4. Register in the Union Registry		
4.1	<p>Click the link to open the Union Registry start page. (https://unionregistry.ec.europa.eu/euregistry/SE/index.xhtml)</p> <p>Click Login in column to the left on the page.</p>	
4.2	<p>Select verification method EU Login Mobile App QR code and click Sign in.</p> <p>Scan the QR code with the mobile app and then enter the generated code.</p>	
4.3	<p>Click Fill in your personal details in the column to the left on the page.</p>	
4.4	<p>A registration form is displayed.</p> <p>Select the same type of ID document that you will provide in your paper application.</p> <p>After you have entered your information, a summary will be displayed. Click Submit if everything is correct.</p>

4.5	<p style="text-align: center;">You are now registered in the Union Registry!</p> <p>As a newly registered user, a box with your URID is displayed on screen. A colleague already registered as a user and representative will need this URID to register you as a representative on accounts in the registry. Your URID is always visible in the top left part of the page when you are logged in.</p> <div data-bbox="443 414 1506 510" style="background-color: #c8e6c9; padding: 10px; text-align: center;"><p>You have now been registered. Your unique Registry Identifier is EU352510233162. Please communicate this identifier to your account holder(s) for use in account opening requests.</p></div> <p>When you have been added as a representative on an account, an enrolment key is needed to activate your user in the registry.
