

Call for proposals for Efficiency of Energy Use in Industry – Research and Development programme

The Swedish Energy Agency is calling for proposals for SEK 32.9 million in remaining funds in the Efficiency of Energy Use in Industry – Research and Development (*Industrins energianvändning – forskning och utveckling*) programme. The call is open for applications in all the programme categories but prioritises project proposals in category three: Interplay between industry players or between industry and society (*Samspel mellan industrier eller mellan industri och samhälle*) and projects where different types of players collaborate or international collaboration projects. The closing application date is 27 January 2016.

The programme provides funding for research, development and demonstration projects at universities, university colleges, institutes, consultancies and industry players.

Before sending an application to the Swedish Energy Agency the applicant should read and observe:

- The description of the "Efficiency of Energy Use in Industry Research and Development" programme, for detailed information about the programme's research and development areas, specialisations and boundaries.
- The assessment criteria and application instructions for information about what you should include in your application and which criteria are used in the assessment of applications.

How to apply

Project applications should be submitted via the Swedish Energy Agency's electronic application tool "E-kanalen" by 27 January 2016 at the latest. To send an application via "E-kanalen" you need to create a user account. It is the project manager's task to send the application and to apply for a user account. Please note that setting up a new user account can take up to one working day.

Funding decision

Applications are assessed by the programme council. The council will send a recommendation to the Swedish Energy Agency regarding which project should be granted funding. The final decision is expected to be made by the Swedish Energy Agency at the end of May 2016. Projects in the programme can start in June 2016 at the earliest and end by 31 December 2019 at the latest.

Processing of applications

Incoming applications are public documents and can therefore be subject to disclosure. Please state in the application if there are any aspects of the application that are confidential.



Funding is normally paid in accordance with the Swedish Ordinance (2008:761) on state aid to research and development and innovation in the energy sector. The total public funding provided for a project may not exceed the percentage rates specified in the ordinance.
